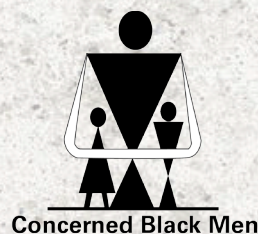


Concerned Black Men of Calvert County 18th Annual "Gala By the Bay" Scholarship Banquet
